Sister Elizabeth Davis, RSM will provide a talk on *Theological Formation in the 21st Century: Boundary Walking, Radical Inclusion, Creative Weaving*. During our time together we will explore theological formation in the context of our work today, a world marked by changing demographics, a new face of family, increasing poverty in the midst of unimaginable wealth, tragic abuse, a rise in fundamentalism and radical extremism, increasing number of refugees, globalization and new understandings of cosmology and ecology.

Elizabeth M. Davis, RSM, Congregational Leader of the Sisters of Mercy of Newfoundland and Labrador, was first a high school teacher in four schools in Newfoundland, then Administrator of St. Clare's Mercy Hospital in St. John's and founding President/CEO of the Health Care Corporation of St. John's. She has been a member of the Medical Council of Canada, the National Board of Medical Examiners (USA), the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada, the Catholic Health Association of Canada, the Canadian Biblical Association, the Trudeau Foundation and Regis College in Toronto.

She has received honorary degrees (Doctor of Laws) from Memorial University of Newfoundland and the University of Manitoba, has been appointed as a Member of the Order of Canada and an Honorary Fellow of the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada, has received the *Bread and Roses Award* from the Canadian Federation of Nurses' Unions, has been named *Alumna of the Year* for Memorial University, and has been inducted into the Order of Newfoundland and Labrador.
