

Bulletin to Queen's College Students Regarding Classes During Pandemic

Hi: Today, Sunday, March 15th, Memorial University (MUN) announced a change for all classes and on-campus activities for the rest of the Winter 2020 Semester. I want to advise you of how Queen's College will adjust to the situation. Please note the following:

Degree Level Courses

All our courses are already available online, thus we will not need time to redesign the course delivery.

3000 Level courses will continue on schedule as usual. We will not have an interruption of classes.

Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday (March 16 – 18) we will sustain our regular schedule for classes, worship, and community meal.

From Thursday, March 19 onward, classes will be delivered **online only**. Students will not attend classes on campus.

Instructors will advise you of any specific adjustments in their respective courses.

Associate Level Courses

There are no foreseeable changes for Associate Level courses.

Diploma Sessions

We will be consulting with the Diploma Program Coordinators and providing information soon. Needless to say, there will likely be adjustments needed to ensure compliance with directives regarding gatherings and social distancing.

College Activities

From Thursday, March 19 until further notice, we will not have face-to-face gatherings on Campus. This includes Chapel and Worship activities, Vocational Development Seminars, and community meals.

The General Office will be open, as usual.

The Reading Room will be available as usual.

We will be monitoring developments and keeping you up to date on matters pertaining to our programs and activities, including Convocation 2020.

Please be careful and take the necessary steps to protect yourself and to protect others.
