

Vaccination Declaration Form

Vaccination is one of the most effective ways to protect our families, communities and ourselves against COVID-19. Vaccines are proven to prevent severe illness, hospitalization and death from COVID-19. As a part of Memorial's commitment and shared responsibility to keep each other and our extended families safe during the upcoming school year, we are requiring all students, faculty and staff to be vaccinated against COVID-19.

Students, faculty and staff will require the first dose of an approved vaccination by Sept. 7, 2021, and the second dose by Oct. 15, 2021, unless granted an exemption. Recognized vaccines include those approved by the [World Health Organization \(WHO\)](#) and/or [Health Canada](#).

Please complete this form by Sept. 7, 2021 to indicate your vaccination status or request for exemption. Proof of vaccination must be submitted to Queen's General Office to meet Memorial's vaccination requirement. Proof of vaccination can be downloaded from your provincial health webpage. Access to the information will be limited to those individuals who require access in order to fulfill that purpose. By completing this form, I understand and agree that my vaccination and contact information may be used by and disclosed to units and/or third party service providers for the purposes of facilitating exemption requests, testing and aggregate reporting in compliance with Memorial's vaccine requirement and testing program.
