The final Day of Awareness for the semester took place March 25th. An Iona Morning Devotion based on the Creation of God was followed by Dr Michelle Rebidoux's presentation: 'Finding Art in

Creation, Finding God in Creation'. Dr Michelle shared some insights from the Jewish German philosopher Martin Buber's classic work "I and Thou", and used those insights to guide two contemplative exercises. The first contemplative reflection was based on Gerry Squire's "Spirit of the Beothuck" situated in Boyd's Cove, NL. Dr Michelle then shared her own personal journey in painting. One major art work of Dr Michelle's can be found in St Mark's Church, St John's, on the symbols of the four Gospels (see link). She shared that another of her paintings, 'Jacob Wrestling with the Angel', took six years to take shape in her mind, explaining her process in its creation. She also shared some of her poetry. First night \$50.00;

Second & subsequent nights \$35.00

The College reserves the right to cancel reservations if the apartment is needed for College use. Full refund of the deposit will be made if the College cancels a reservation.
