	Apocrypha, Dead Sea Scrolls, Pseudepigrapha) and secondary writings by		
	scholars in the field of Biblical Studies. We will also consider our own modern		
	biases and use different approaches to understanding the Biblical text (e.g.		
	historical approach, feminist readings, literary criticism).
