Course Description: In this course, we will examine the lives and roles of women in the biblical world as told to us in ancient texts. Each week will focus on a different female figure (or figures), placing her/them within her/their historical and cultural contexts. We will read primary texts (e.g. Old Testament/Hebrew Bible, New Testament, Apocrypha, Dead Sea Scrolls, Pseudepigrapha) and secondary writings by scholars in the field of Biblical Studies. We will also consider our own modern biases and use different approaches to understanding the Biblical text (e.g. historical approach, feminist readings, literary criticism).
