1 Introduction

1.1 Purpose

If you have seen the Table of Contents, you'll know that this booklet is intended for people of all faiths. As a disclaimer, I'm a traditional prayerbook Anglican,¹ but I've tried to be objective.

This document was written to help those interested in finding a faith community that would be appropriate for them. Also, there may be people who simply want to learn more about the religious life of St. John's and the surrounding area. I have tried to be inclusive, addressing not only all Christian denominations, but also other religions. For brevity, I have used the word *church* to mean (unless the context implies otherwise) a church or other place of worship.

1.2 How to Use This Booklet

If you are reading this as a pdf file, you will see that the Table of Contents is linked electronically to the sections of the document. There are five principal denominations in this area: the *Anglican Church of Canada*, the *Pentecostal Assemblies of Newfoundland and Labrador*, the *Roman Catholic Church*, the *Salvation Army*, and the *United Church of Canada*. There is a section for each,² plus another section for all other Christian churches, and finally a section for all other places of worship. If you do not see what you are looking for in the Table of Contents, then try the Index at the back of the book. It is easy to say whether or not a church belongs to one of the five principal denominations. Faith communities which are not part of these five denominations but which are clearly Christian have been placed in the "Other Christian Churches" section. All other faith communities have been placed in the "Other Places of Worship" section.

1.3 What's In, and What's Out

I have included every church in or near St. John's of which I am aware. The coverage area includes St. John's, Mount Pearl, Paradise, St. Philip's-Portugal Cove, and Torbay. If I have omitted anything, please advise me by email (see below). This document is meant to be primarily a living resource rather than an historical archive. However, the final section of the document does provide information about the major changes that have occurred since the first edition of this document (6 August 2010).

For each church I have given (if applicable) contact information such as location, mailing address, telephone number, email address, and website address. ³ Where there is a publicly accessible Facebook address this information has been provided too, omitting the common pre-

¹The Anglican Church of Canada uses both the *Book of Common Prayer* (1962) and the *Book of Alternative Services* (1985). The former uses traditional language, and the latter uses contemporary language. Here is an example:

Te Deum (BCP, page 7) We praise thee O God; we acknowledge thee to be the Lord. All the earth doth worship thee, the Father everlasting.

You are God (BAS, page 94) You are God: we praise you; you are the Lord: we acclaim you; you are the eternal Father: all creation worships you.

In most cases, churches are in their own buildings, but in some cases they are simply renting a room in a building somewhere. I have provided information for both situations, but only provide photographs for buildings primarily used for religious purposes. I have not given the names of clergy, nor the times of services.

During the pandemic, some churches started to make recordings of their services available on YouTube or other platforms.⁴ By checking the websites of the churches which are of interest, the reader can see if recordings have been made available.
