### 1 Introduction

#### 1.1 Purpose

If you have seen the Table of Contents, you would know that this booklet is intended for people of all faiths. As a disclaimer, I'm a traditional prayerbook Anglican, but I've tried to be objective.

This document was written to help those interested in finding a faith community that would be appropriate for them. Also, there may be people who simply want to learn more about the religious life of St. John's and the surrounding area. I have tried to be inclusive, addressing not only all Christian denominations, but also other religions. For brevity, I have used the word *church* to mean (unless the context implies otherwise) a church or other place of worship.

#### 1.2 How to Use This Booklet

If you are reading this as a pdf file, you will see that the Table of Contents is linked electronically to the sections of the document. There are five principal denominations in this area, which in alphabetical order are: the *Anglican Church of Canada*, the *Pentecostal Assemblies of Newfoundland and Labrador*, the *Roman Catholic Church*, the *Salvation Army*, and the *United Church of Canada*. There is a section for each,<sup>2</sup> plus another section for all other Christian churches, and finally a section for all other places

of worship. If you do not see what you are looking for in the Table of Contents, then try the Index at the back of the book. It is easy to say whether or not a church belongs to one of the five principal denominations. Faith communities which are not part of these five denominations but which are clearly Christian have been placed in the "Other Christian Churches" section. All other faith communities have been placed in the "Other Places of Worship" section. In each of these eight sections, entries have mostly been made in alphabetical order; exceptions are made for the Anglican Cathedral and the Roman Catholic Basilica, which begin their respective sections.

#### 1.3 What's In, and What's Out

I have included every church in or near St. John's of which I am aware. The coverage area includes St. John's, Mount Pearl, Paradise, St. Philip's-Portugal Cove, and Torbay. If I have omitted anything, please advise me by email (see below). This document is meant to be primarily a living resource rather than an historical archive. However, the final section of the document does provide information about the major changes that have occurred since the first edition of this document (6 August 2010).

For each church I have given (if applicable) contact information such as location, mailing address, telephone number, email address, and web-

site address. <sup>3</sup> Where there is a publicly accessible Facebook address this information has been provided too, omitting the common prefix https://www.facebook.com/. In most cases, churches are in their own buildings, but in some cases they are simply renting a room in a building somewhere. I have provided information for both situations, but only provide photographs for buildings primarily used for religious purposes. I have not given the names of clergy, nor the times of services.

Next to the address of almost every church or other place of worship, there is a link to a Google map. Most maps show about 100 metres north and 100 metres south of the location; in some areas these distances have been increased for clarity. Hitting the minus key (–) on the right hand side of the map will increase these distances.

During the pandemic, some churches started to make recordings of their services available on YouTube or other platforms.<sup>4</sup> By checking the websites of the churches which are of interest, the reader can see if recordings have been made available.

#### 1.4 Credits

The picture on the cover page is that of the altar and reredos of the Anglican Cathedral. It is used with kind permission of Janine Sheppard. The picture of the Church of the Good Samaritan on page 20 was cropped from a picture sent to me by the Reverend Colton Carrick.

Information has come from a variety of sources such as websites, the media, and in some cases contacting persons for information. In particular, for many years I received much support from the late George Powell, who had been President of the St. John's and Area Council of

Churches, and who had contributed to many other organizations as well. As this is not an academic publication, I have not used footnotes to cite each source, but I wish in this section to acknowledge the contributions made by others.

### 9 Major Changes

#### 9.1 2010

- 1. The closure of the New Life Fellowship (Southern Baptist) was noted on 29 October 2010.
- 2. The closure of the Unitarian Universalist Fellowship was noted on 1 November 2010.
- 3. The Church of St. Michael and All Angels (Anglican) left its downtown building; this was noted on 16 December 2010.

#### 9.2 2011

No major changes.

#### 9.3 2012

- 1. The congregation of Trinity United Church in Mount Pearl amalgamated with First United Church (page 16); the separate entry for Trinity United Church was delisted on 28 February 2012.
- 2. There is a new building in Paradise for the Jehovah's Witnesses (noted on 16 May 2012), replacing the building located in Mount Pearl.

- 3. A new non-denominational congregation, the Emmanuel Chinese Church, has been formed and is worshipping at St. Augustine's Anglican Church (noted on 16 May 2012).
- 4. There is a new church in Torbay called the Torbay Family Church (PAONL) (noted on 9 July 2012).

#### 9.4 2013

1. The Avalon Wesleyan Church closed in April 2013.

#### 9.5 2014

- 1. Moravian services in St. John's have ended; the listing was deleted in April 2014.
- 2. The Lighthouse of Hope (United Pentecostal Church) has closed; the listing was deleted in April 2014.
- 3. The new building for St. Michael and All Angels opened on Maundy Thursday, 17 April 2014.

#### 9.6 2015

1. The Torbay Family Church (PAONL) announced that services were being suspended in August, 2015. Its website went dark in October; the entry has been deleted.

#### 9.7 2016

No major changes.

#### 9.8 2017

1. Christian Missionary Fellowship International was added in August, 2017.

2. Vineyard Fellowship closed in December, 2017.

#### 9.9 2018

- 1. In January the CBC reported a new PAONL initiative called *Local Church*.
- 2. In April, 2018 Calvary Baptist sold its building on Kenmount Road, and moved to the Seventh-day Adventist Church on Aldershot Street.
- 3. True Life Church was added in June, 2018.

#### 9.10 2019

- 1. St. Stephen, Protomartyr, Anglican Catholic has closed.
- 2. A new church called Lighthouse Apostolic opened.
- 3. Local Church, a congregation of the PAONL, has closed.

#### 9.11 2020

 CMFI (Christian Missionary Fellowship International) moved into a new building at 40 International Place, St. John's, September, 2020.

#### 9.12 2021

- 1. Good Samaritan (Anglican Network in Canada) moved into a renovated building at 10 St. Clare Avenue, St. John's.
- 2. Emmanuel Chinese Church was deleted. Its website was no longer current, and no reply to a request for information was received.

- 3. Chabad of Newfoundland (Jewish, Orthodox) was added.
- 4. Al-Huda Islamic Centre was added.
- 5. Mount Olives (Anglican Diocese of the Trinity) was added.
- Kilbride Community Church (CBAC Canadian Baptists of Atlantic Canada) was added.
- 7. Deeper Life Bible Church was added.

#### 9.13 2022

- 1. True Life Church has closed.
- 2. Grace Family Fellowship has closed.
- 3. Pathway Community Church (Salvation Army) has closed.
- 4. Holy Family Church (Roman Catholic) closed in March.
- 5. St. John's Korean International was added in June.
- 6. Corpus Christi Church (Roman Catholic) closed in August.
- 7. Holy Rosary in Portugal Cove St. Philip's has closed.
- 8. St. John Bosco in Shea Heights has closed.
- 9. Mary Queen of Peace in St. John's has closed.
- 10. Mary Queen of the World in Mount Pearl has closed.
- 11. St. Peter's in Mount Pearl has been renamed Our Lady, Queen of Families.
- 12. St. Pius X in St. John's has closed.

13. St. Michael and all Angels (Anglican) no longer owns its own building as of December 1, but continues to hold services at the Cathedral.

#### 9.14 2023

- George Street United Church held, founded nearly 150 years ago as George Street Methodist Church, has closed due to financial problems. Services were suspended in June, but there was a final service held on October 29 to decommission the church.
- 2. It appears that Shambhala Buddhism has closed, and therefore its entry in this directory has been deleted.
- 3. St. Michael and All Angels, an Anglican church established in the 19th century, was disestablished on August 31.
- 4. RCCG Mount Zion Parish was added, September, 2023.
- 5. Gospel Hall moved from 47 Smith Avenue to 75 Kiwanis Street.

1. The Christadelphians have been removed from this directory. Efforts to contact this group were unsuccessful.

- 7. Kilbride Community Church was renamed Route 10 Community Church.
- 8. Cochrane Street United Church closed at the end of November.
- 9. The Korean International church has become inactive, and therefore it has been removed from this directory.

#### 9.16 2025

 The Muslim Association of Newfoundland and Labrador has purchased the former Mary Queen of Peace Church at 135 Torbay Road. They plan to renovate and then open this facility as a new mosque in 2025.
